Summer Camp Tuition and Attendance Policy

We recognize that the summer time is an active travel/activity time for many families. **Therefore, if you provide us in writing by April 21, 2017, the weeks/days your child will attend summer camp, you will be charged only for the days you have reserved for your child.** The attached 2017 Summer Camp Attendance Form should be used to provide attendance information. This will allow us to appropriately plan staffing requirements which allows us to provide this billing option.

If we do not receive your Summer Camp Attendance Form in writing by April 21, 2017, you will be billed the tuition rate for the weekly attendance program you select (5, 3, or 2 days per week), every week of camp from your start date.

There is a Material/Fuel fee of \$98.00 for summer camp. Tuition for the 5 day program is \$186.00 weekly, the 3 day program is \$160.00 weekly and the 2 day program is \$139.00 weekly. These rates do include field trip costs. Tuition is due the Friday preceding the camp week. When tuition is not paid by Tuesday of the camp week, a late fee of \$10.00 will be applied.

A Parent Orientation document will be sent via email to all registered families 2 weeks prior to the start of camp. Please review this information to learn about water days, sunscreen, field trips policies, and other important information.

If your child is in attendance on a day his/her group is going on a field trip, then your child must attend the field trip. Due to age differences, staffing, and ratio requirements, children may not remain at the center with a different age group. This requirement allows us to maintain our high program standards with the planned activities for each age group. Due to changes in Georgia State law governing child care facilities, children under the age of 5 will not be able to go on field trips. These children will remain at the center on field trip days, with a fun filled day of scheduled activities. We will plan special outside activities for these days. As soon as a child turns 5 they will be able to participate in all field trips

Super Summer Camp Rules and Safety Policies

Here are some important safety guidelines:

When bringing or picking up your child, please park in the lot when possible. If it is raining, please pull your car up far enough to allow others to pull up behind you. The double yellow lines are a walkway; please do not park on them. Please do not leave young children sitting in the car by themselves

Please clock your child in and out every day. State regulations require that at drop off time a teacher receives your child. Please also be sure that the teacher acknowledges you picking up your child.

Please discuss the following rules with your child and sign the bottom of this form:

- The safety of the children is of the utmost importance to us. Children must follow all instructions at all times. **Any child unable to follow our rules will not be permitted to participate in our field trips.**
- Any child that removes their yellow arm band during a field trip before the teacher tells them they are allowed to, will not be allowed to go on the next field trip for which they are scheduled. If your child violates this policy a second time program suspension may occur.
- We must use safe bus behavior. Children may not be loud while on the bus and may never stand up while the bus is in motion. Seat belts must be worn. It's the law! No rough housing of any kind is allowed on the bus.
- Show respect to all adults, other children, camp supplies and equipment. We do not allow disrespectful behavior, bullying, violence, dangerous play or foul language. **First offense of this rule will result in a note being sent home, second offense will result in a phone call to the parent, third offense will result in parent conference, fourth offense will result in being sent home from the program, a fifth offense may result in expulsion from the program.**
- Children may not bring toys from home, except on game day as specified by the teachers.
- Keep your body parts to yourself.
- Keep the bus and rooms clean. Participate in clean-up time.
- **Children must wear tennis shoes or a shoe type other than sandals.** Injuries occur to the feet too easily when open sandals are worn. **Children wearing sandals will not be permitted to go on field trips. Crocs may only be worn during outside water play time.**
- No junk food from home allowed. (No candy, sodas, gum, etc.)
- We are a peanut and nut-free facility—please do not send your child to Kids R Kids with any nut or peanut products in their lunch or snack bags. This includes any products from Chick-fil-A.
- For everyone's safety, we reserve the right to disenroll or bar any child from attending a field trip who chooses to violate our safety rules.

PARENT SUMMER CAMP ORIENTATION

Welcome to Summer Camp 2017. We are so pleased that you have allowed us to share in your child's summer experience. Together with you, the parents, and our awesome staff we will make this a wonderful summer for our campers! We have a lot of exciting field trips, special visitors and creative and challenging activities planned for the summer! Our Clubhouse 3 this summer will consist of campers graduating from 1st through 5th grades. Our Clubhouse 2 this summer consists of campers graduating from Pre-K who are 5 years old and Kindergarten graduates. Parents of our Private Pre-K / Kindergarten Preparatory class are also receiving this information because much of it applies due to field trips and summer activities. Here are a few basics you need to know.

ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES

- Please walk your children to their classrooms and speak to the teacher at arrival and pick up. The camp staff is responsible to make sure all children are present and accounted for. Camp staff can also remind parents of the specific requirements for the following day's activities when they see you. If your child needs to re-enter the school after departure you must accompany them back inside all the way to their room.
- Campers arriving before 7:00am will go to the cafe where breakfast is being served. Clubhouse 3 room (back of building all the way to the left) opens at 7:00am and arriving Clubhouse 2 & 3 campers go there once open. Breakfast is continued in Clubhouse 3 until 8am. Private Pre-K / Kindergarten Preparatory opens at 7:00am and those students go there once open where breakfast is continued until 8 am. If your child brings his or her own breakfast to school and arrives after 8:00 am, you may sit with your child in the cafe to finish his/her breakfast. Children arriving after 8:00 am may not take their breakfast to the classroom.
- Upon arrival to your child's classroom or the cafe, you will sign your child in on the Child Tracking Form located at the front of the classroom. We will be happy to assist you as needed to complete this form. Please let us know if you need help.

CUBBIES

- Each child will have an assigned basket in which to keep their personal items. This is not a very large basket so please keep this in mind. It is also not a secured basket such as a locker.

SUNSCREEN / HEALTH AND SAFETY

The health and safety of your child is paramount to us. In the state of Georgia sunscreen is necessary. We take every precaution to keep your children safe.

- The campers are outside each day, weather permitting. It is required that you provide a bottle of sunscreen with a sunscreen permission form for your child on the first day of camp. This sunscreen will be kept at school with your child's teacher.
- Please make sure that the sunscreen has not expired and that you send two separate bottles if you have children in two separate groups.
- Please write your child's first and last name using a permanent marker on the sunscreen.
- Please remember to apply the 1st round of sunscreen each day before bringing your child to camp. The teachers will apply the second round in the afternoon prior to their outside time.
- No open toed shoes, Crocs, Flip-flops or Jellies are allowed for daily wear. These shoes can be worn during water play times.
- Any condition your camper may have that requires any type of medical attention (food allergies, insect bite allergies) will require the completion of our Allergy Medical Plan Form and the form and medication needed must be on-site before your child may attend.

FIELD TRIP REQUIREMENTS

- A field trip permission form must be signed by you for your child to attend the field trips. These forms will be in color coded binders for each separate group, Clubhouse 2, Clubhouse 3, and Private Pre-K / Kindergarten Preparatory. Clubhouse 3 = BLUE, Clubhouse 2 = ORANGE. Private Pre-K / Kindergarten field trip forms will be on the classroom door for sign up the week prior to the trip. The color coded notebooks are kept in the café for your convenience prior to the camp rooms opening and are moved to each respective camp room as it opens.
- For Clubhouse 2 & 3, we recommend that you go through the field trip binder and sign all the attended field trip permission forms for your child at once. We do not have field trips planned the first week, May 30 – June 2 which allows you time for this responsibility.
- Some field trips (Braves game, Center for Puppetry Arts and others) require the purchase of tickets in advance. It is critical that you sign your child up for these when he/she starts our program in order to be assured a space. Some field trips require special permission forms or items brought from home. These will be noted on the permission forms and the Clubhouse Weekly Newsletters.
- The Clubhouse Weekly Newsletter will be emailed to you each Friday for the upcoming week. If you prefer a hard copy, please let your teacher know. Please always check these for important requirements for the next week's field trips such as water bottles, gear for wet activities, socks, sack lunches, and special waivers.
- If your camper is attending on a field trip day, he/she must go on the field trip.
- The Field Trip Calendars are very important to keep handy. They are available on our website and they were included in your Summer Camp Registration Package. These calendars tell you when a sack lunch is needed, when campers may bring money for a trip and the departure and return times for the trip. Your child should be at camp 30 minutes prior to departure.

- Water bottles may be brought for any field trip day. Some field trips require water bottles and will be defined for you in the Clubhouse Weekly Newsletter for the upcoming week.

Snacks, Breakfast and Lunch

- If your camper arrives before 7:50am, he/she will receive breakfast. Breakfast ends at 8:00am.
- Your camper will receive a snack every afternoon.
- All lunches are provided by our school with the exception of a few field trip days in which there are no options for food at the field trip location. The field trips requiring the camper to bring his/her own sack lunch are clearly identified on the Field Trip Calendars.
- **We are a nut free center.** Please do not send your camper in with peanut butter or any tree nut food items in their sack lunches as we have children with life threatening allergies.
- Your camper's lunch sack must be labeled with your camper's first and last name and the date.
- Please always give the sack lunch to your camper's teacher. Sack lunches may not be kept in the backpacks or cubbies.

WATER PLAY DAYS

- During the first week of camp, all 3 groups will have a turn to participate in use of the on-site water spray park.
- In the first week of June we will start our regularly scheduled Water Days. CH 2's water day is on Tuesday's from 10:15 – 11:15 am and CH 3's water day will be on Wednesday's from 1 – 2 pm. Private Pre-K / Kindergarten Preparatory's water day is Monday 10:15 – 11:15.
- Please send your child to school in their swimsuit on all water days. Please always send a towel and their change of clothes. They must bring a pair of Crocs or water shoes to put on during water play but must wear regular closed toe shoes for the rest of the day.
- Due to licensing, no plastic bags are allowed at our center. Please be sure that you send your child w/ a back pack or cloth bag that is waterproof.

USE OF ELECTRONIC DEVICES (iPod, iPods, Handheld Gaming Devices, etc.)

- The school provides use of a Wii and Xbox 360 Connect game systems. All games are E rated. Time is limited and equally shared for all campers.
- Children may bring in a hand held device and one "E" rated game. WE DO NOT ALLOW HAND HELD DEVICES THAT ARE CAPABLE OF TAKING PICTURES OR VIDEOS. THIS INCLUDES BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO PHONES, TABLETS AND HAND HELD GAMING DEVICES. PLEASE LABEL ITEMS WITH THE CAMPER'S FIRST AND LAST NAME. KRK is not responsible for any lost items.
- Campers may not bring cell phones or devices with internet/Wi-Fi access.
- There are a couple designated brief periods during the day which we consider down time and these are the only times that children are allowed to utilize these items. Our day is very busy and chocked full of lots of exciting activities.

MOVIES

- Clubhouse 2 and Clubhouse 3 will have a movie time once each week. Movie time is a short period during our quiet time. We can't wait for the popcorn to be ready!
- The ratings are as follows... We watch only "G" rated movies in CH 2 on Friday and a "G" or "PG" for CH 3 on Thursday. We will advise you of the movie in advance and ask that you sign a permission form.

IMPORTANT PAPERWORK

- Each camper must have a Summer Camp Packet (the one in which you define the attendance days) and current registration paperwork (the registration papers used to define authorized pick up people, emergency contacts, transportation agreement, child profile, and other information) on file at KRK prior to their first day of camp.
- If it has been a year since you last filled the registration paperwork out you will need to complete a new one. It is a state licensing requirement that this information be updated once yearly. All of these must be brought in and reviewed at a minimum by the Friday before the camper's first day of attendance.
- If you have listed any allergies on the application, we must have our Allergy Medical Plan Form filled out by your camper's doctor with the appropriate medication for this allergy at our site prior to their first day of attendance. We apologize now that we cannot make any exceptions to this requirement. We cannot have knowledge of an allergy that requires medical attention without the appropriate "Allergy Medical Plan Form" from the doctor and the medication. We cannot have one without the other.

We look forward to having a lot of fun with your camper this summer!!

5. Summer Camp Attendance Change Form – This is for your future use should you need to request a change in your child's attendance. This form will also be on our website in the parent area under "Online Forms".
